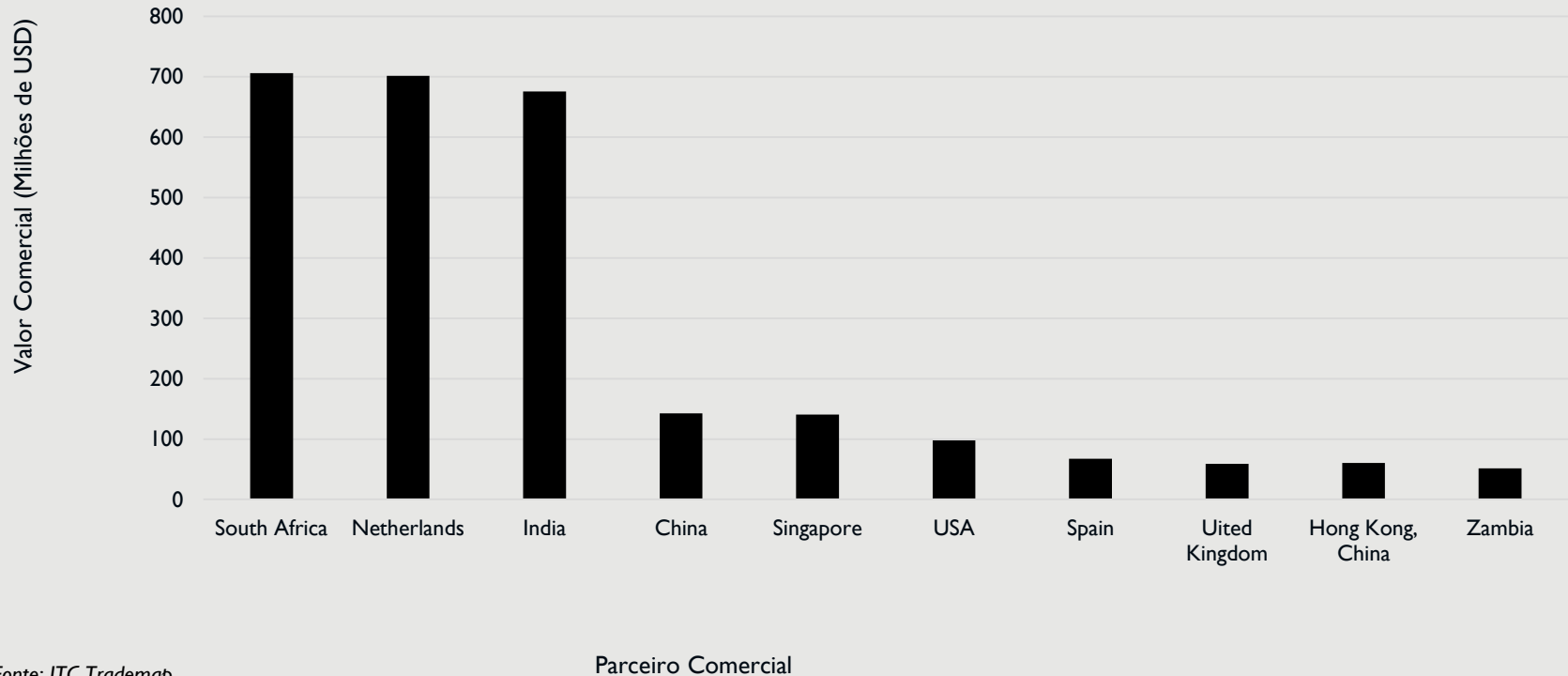
HAS MOZAMBIQUE BENEFITED FROM AGOA?

Mozambique has been eligible for AGOA since 2000 and has benefited from this program. Its highest utilization of AGOA in terms of total value of exports has been recorded between the years **2003-2005**, with a yearly average of **\$2.36 million USD**.

Since 2008, Mozambique's AGOA utilization has declined, mostly due to the collapse of the apparel industry.

In recent years (**2014-2016**), yearly average value of exports to the US under AGOA was **\$852,000 USD**, which entered the US duty-free. There is room for Mozambique to take better advantage of AGOA, and increase its utilization.

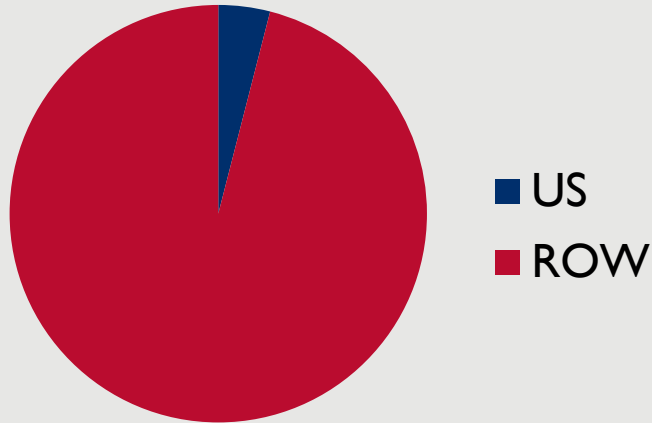
Exportações de Mocambique por Pais de destino (2016)



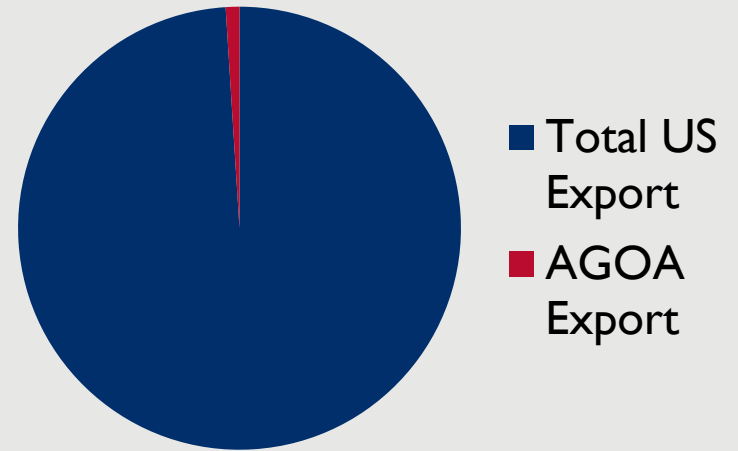

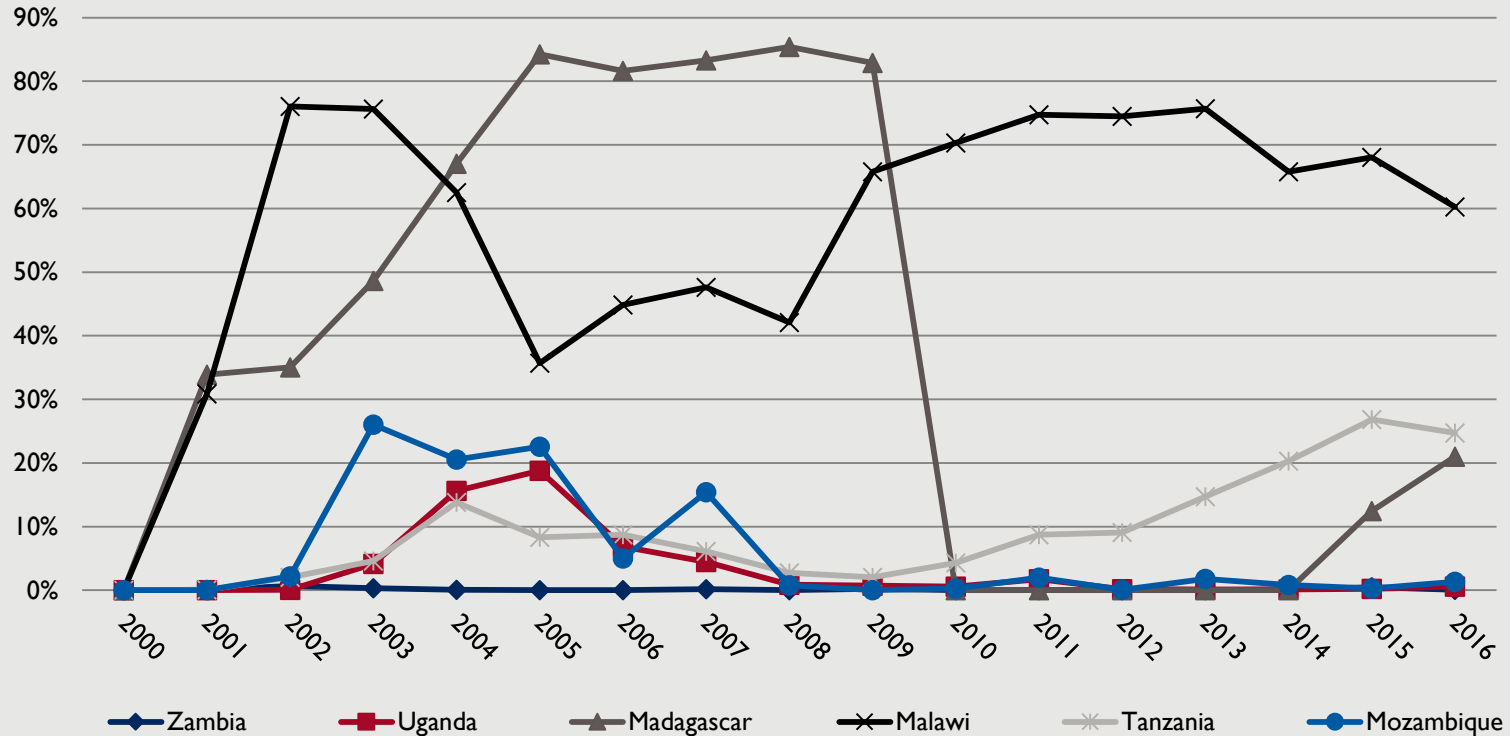
Mozambique Exports



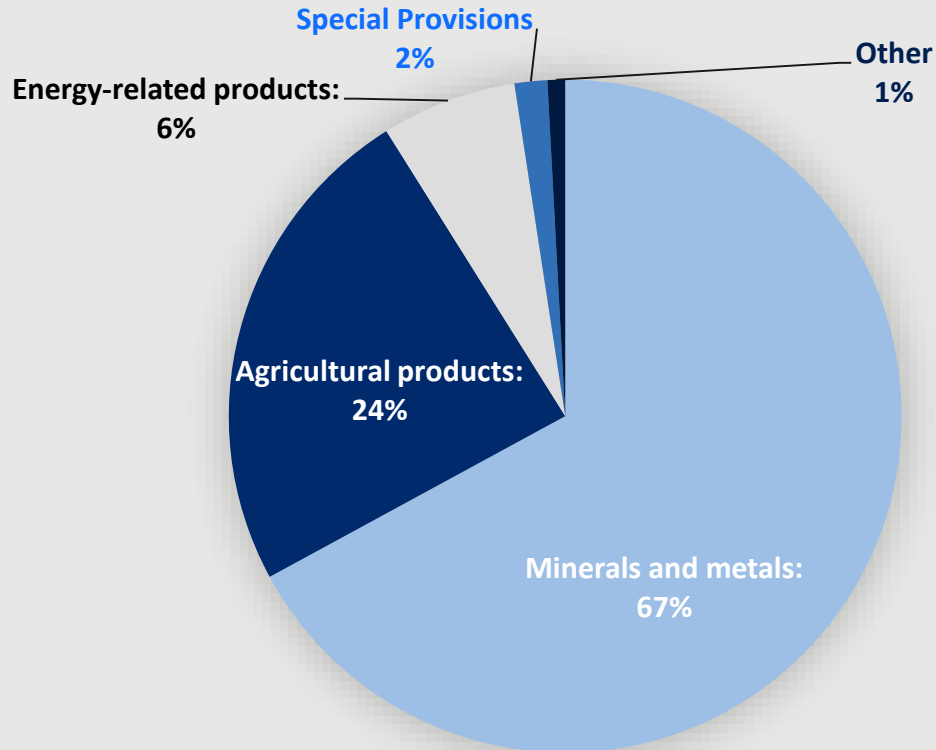
