

Mozambique's Natural Resource Boom

What potential impacts on the competitiveness of Mozambique's **Tomato** industry?





Approximately **271,000** households (smallholder farmers) cultivate tomatoes in Mozambique





The competitiveness of Mozambique's tomato industry is driven by imported inputs and hired labor





Mozambique's tomato industry shows strong resilience to Dutch Disease

One of the potential effects of Mozambique's impending resource boom is an appreciation of the Metical (one consequence of the phenomenon known as "Dutch Disease")



3

This means domestic buyers would need fewer Metical to buy the same amount of imported tomato

> This would result in a loss of competiveness of Mozambican tomato relative to tomato imported from countries where currencies have not undergone a similar appreciation
